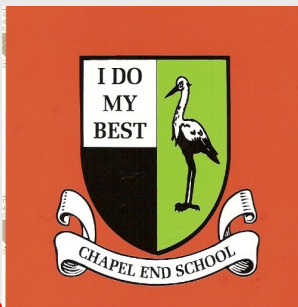
We now look forward to productions, sports day, summer fayres, leavers assemblies and many more wonderful events at which you will create life-long memories.

Red round-neck school jumper preferably displaying the Chapel End Primary School emblem.
White polo T-shirt

Girls Uniform

Red round-neck school jumper or red school cardigan preferably displaying the Chapel End Primary School emblem.
White polo T-shirt
Plain grey pinafore, grey skirt (appropriate length) or grey trousers
Red gingham dress in summer (red and white checks)
Red gingham all-in-one Years 3-6
Grey tights
White socks (recommended for Summer) Grey socks (recommended for Winter)

Footwear

We want our children's feet to be healthy and flourish, therefore all pupils must wear sensible, well-fitting shoes with an appropriate low heel. Boots are not allowed in the classroom, therefore on bad weather days if your child wears boots to school they must remember to bring their school shoes to change into. Trainers are not allowed to be worn in school with the exception of times when children are participating in planned physical activities.

Nursery

Children of Nursery age are permitted to wear black or grey jogging trousers to support gross motor skill activities and toilet training.

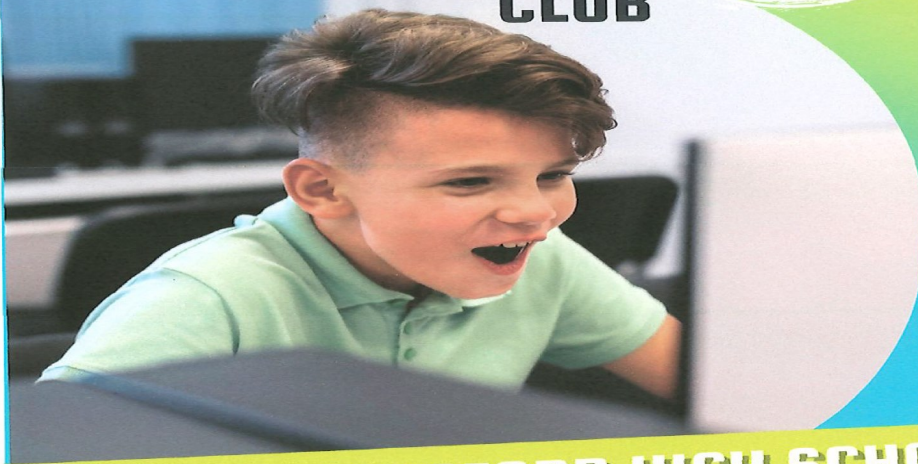
If you are planning on ordering a new PE kit, please be aware that, due to a change in supplier, there is now a new size guide.
