We will be opening up the school to our current school families and past staff, governors and pupils from years gone by.

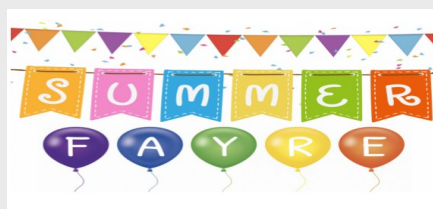

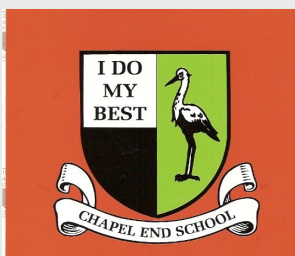

Uniform Orders



New uniforms can be ordered through school. Uniform order forms are available from the dispenser in the entrance hall and on Chapel End Spider, in the virtual office. Please return your orders to school, we will then add the cost of your order onto your child's **SchoolMoney** account to enable you to make payment. To ensure delivery before we finish for the summer please send orders to school as soon as possible. Please write your child's name clearly on the order form, as this will be printed on the label inside the garments you order. Please ensure the form is completed correctly i.e. size and item required.

School Uniform Shop

Our onsite uniform shop is open before and after school in our Breakfast/After School Club room. Parents and carers are able to purchase items of uniform for £2 each or 3 for £5. All polo shirts are 2 for £1. Any items purchased can be paid in cash or on School Money, Thank you.

Boys Uniform

Red round-neck school jumper preferably displaying the Chapel End Primary School emblem.
White polo T-shirt
Grey trousers/short-trousers in summer

Girls Uniform

Red round-neck school jumper or red school cardigan preferably displaying the Chapel End Primary School emblem.
White polo T-shirt
Plain grey pinafore, grey skirt (appropriate length) or grey trousers
Red gingham dress in summer (red and white checks)
Red gingham all-in-one Years 3-6
Grey tights
White socks (recommended for Summer) Grey socks (recommended for Winter)

Footwear

We want our children's feet to be healthy and flourish, therefore all pupils must wear sensible, well-fitting shoes with an appropriate low heel. Boots are not allowed in the classroom, therefore on bad weather days if your child wears boots to school they must remember to bring their school shoes to change into. Trainers are not allowed to be worn in school with the exception of times when children are participating in planned physical activities.

Nursery

Children of Nursery age are permitted to wear black or grey jogging trousers to support gross motor skill activities and toilet training.

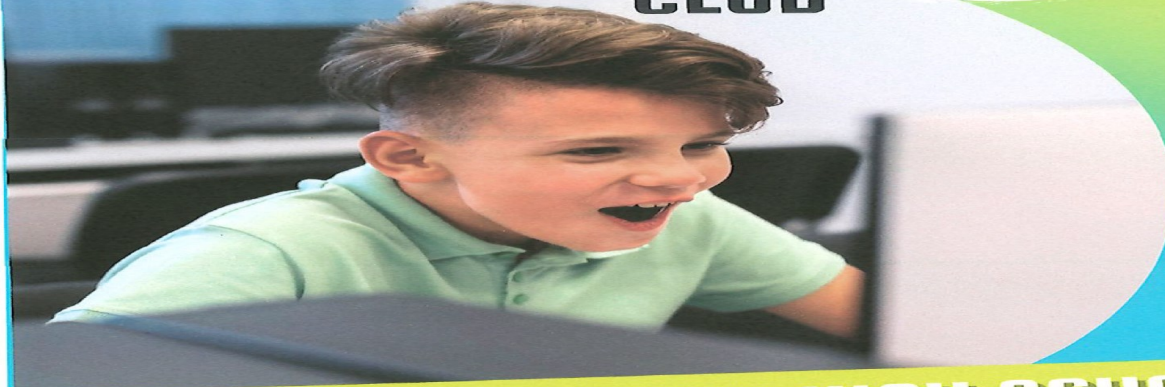
