

## Physical Education and Sports Premium

Reported March 2024



From the period of April 2024- August we will receive **£17,681** as Sports Premium money. This money will be spent in a sustainable and regulated way to ensure we meet our objectives.

Sports Premium will be spent according to the 5 key indicators published by the Department for Education

1. To increase the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity
2. Raise the profile of PE and Sport
3. Increase staff confidence, knowledge and skills in teaching PE and sport
4. Increase the range of sports offered to children
5. Increased participation in competitive sport

### Priorities:

1. Ensure that School sport in addition to the National curriculum offer can be accessed
2. Raise the profile of sport through break and lunchtime provision
