If your child is currently on packed lunches and would like street party food, please pay £2.50 via SchoolMoney and email school to let us know.

Nursery, Y3-6 – Current school meals

Please pay your dinner money as normal and your child will be provided with street party food on the day.

We are delighted to invite parents, carers and our governors to join us for the afternoon to celebrate this event. Families are invited to bring a picnic along to dine on the school field so that we can come together as a community to celebrate.


Each year group will be performing a song from a given decade by a British artist, stretching back to the 50's.

Dinner Money Payments

Please note dinner money is paid <u>in advance of the week</u> via SchoolMoney. Dinner money is £12.50 per week (£2.50 per day).

When you log on to SchoolMoney the figure shown is your current balance either in credit or debit as at that particular day.

Debit Balance

Please remember to pay the figure that is shown as owing **plus** the cost of any remaining meals due to be taken by your child for that week.

Credit Balance

If your balance is in credit, please ensure you have enough credit for any remaining meals due to be taken by your child for that week. If not, a further payment will need to be paid to bring your account up to date.

Fish Friday Payments

Please remember Fish Friday is paid <u>in advance of the term.</u> Fish Friday is £12.50 this term (5 weeks). Please follow the same instructions above if you have not already made your payment to bring your account up to date.

IMPORTANT BREAKFAST CLUB REMINDER:

IF YOUR CHILD HAS NOT BEEN BOOKED INTO BREAKFAST CLUB AND YOU NEED THEM TO GO THAT MORNING, PLEASE ENSURE YOU RING BREAKFAST CLUB BEFOREHAND TO CHECK THERE ARE SPACES - THEY WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED ON THE MORNING IN AN EMERGENCY.

Breakfast/After School Club General Reminder: Bookings should be made <u>a week in advance</u>, but always by FRIDAY for the following week. Please send booking requests by email to chapelend@sthelens.org.uk.

Please remember that payment should also be made in advance. Unless you are paying by childcare vouchers, club payments should be made through your child's SchoolMoney account. When you log on to your child's SchoolMoney account please pay the cost of what your following week's club attendances will amount to. If your child does not then need to attend on a day booked, the payment will go as a credit for the following week.

If your child will not be attending a Breakfast Club session please ensure you ring school and speak to a member of the Breakfast Club staff to inform them (01744 678230 option 3).

<u>Likewise</u>, if your child will not be attending After School Club please leave a message with the school office.

School Uniform

Summer uniform may now be worn and a reminder of the uniform is given below.

Boys Uniform

Red round-neck school jumper <u>displaying the Chapel End Primary School emblem.</u>
White polo T-shirt
Grey trousers/short-trousers in summer
Plain grey socks
Black school shoes



Girls Uniform

Red round-neck school jumper or red school cardigan <u>displaying the Chapel End Primary School emblem.</u>
White polo T-shirt

Plain grey pinafore, grey skirt (appropriate length) or grey trousers

Red gingham dress in summer (red and white checks)

Grey tights

White socks (recommended for Summer) Grey socks (recommended for Winter)

Black Shoes

Girls in KS2 can also wear playsuits as an alternative to summer dresses, provided they are summer dress material (red/white gingham).

Footwear

We want our children's feet to be healthy and flourish, therefore all pupils must wear sensible, well-fitting shoes with an appropriate low heel. Boots are not allowed in the classroom, therefore on bad weather days if your child wears boots to school they must remember to bring their school shoes to change into. Trainers are not allowed to be worn in school with the exception of times when children are participating in planned physical activities.

Nursery

Children of Nursery age are permitted to wear black or grey jogging trousers to support gross motor skill activities and toilet training.

As COVID restrictions have now been lifted ALL children must now be signed in/out by a parent/guardian when attending the above clubs.
