Please remember that payment should also be made in advance. Unless you are paying by childcare vouchers, club payments should be made through your child's SchoolMoney account.

When you log on to your child's SchoolMoney account please pay <u>the cost of what your following week's club</u> <u>attendances</u> will amount to to secure the place. If your child does not then need to attend on a day booked, the payment will go as a credit for the following week.

<u>REMINDER</u>: If your child will not be attending a Breakfast Club session please ensure you ring school and speak to a member of the Breakfast Club staff to inform them (01744 678230 option 3). Likewise, if your child will not be attending After School Club please leave a message with the school office.
