School opening hours in September

To ensure that we achieve the new DFE statutory school hours for primary schools in September we are bringing the start time of the school day forward to 8:45am for all classes. Doors will open at 8:40am and it is expected that all children are settled for registration at 8:45am. Classroom doors will be closed at 8:55am and children arriving after this time will come through the office and be marked as late.

Nursery 15 hours children will be collected at 11:40am, with 30 hours children being collected at 3pm. The EYFS door will remain open from 3pm- 3:15pm so Reception children can be collected.

The end of the school day for children Year 1—Year 6 is 3:15pm.

Payment proformas will be sent out to families on Monday 27th June. When we receive the returned proforma, school will add a payment option to your SchoolMoney account for you to pay £10, which should be paid by 12th July. Please note that no orders can be placed after 12th July.

Tickets for the production are £2 each and will be available to purchase from Tuesday 28th June from the school office (cash only). Tickets are initially limited to 3 tickets per family per show. Numbers are limited to 100 tickets per show and will operate on a first come, first served basis.
