Parents of Year 6 pupils will have received a letter from St Helens Council (or Wigan Council if you are a Wigan resident) about applying for a secondary school place for September 2021, outlining how you can apply online. NB: The closing date for applications is: 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020.

# Admissions to Reception - September 2021

To qualify for admission to Reception in September 2021, children must be aged four on or before 31<sup>st</sup> August 2021. If your child attends a nursery in St Helens, you should have received a letter from St Helens Council outlining how you can apply on-line.

NB: The closing date for applications for Reception 2021 is 15<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

# Admissions to Nursery - January, April & September 2021

If your child turns 3 after 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020 and you wish to apply for January, April or September 2021 admission please email <u>schooladmissions@sthelens.gov.uk</u> to request an application form as the online system has now closed.
